Shennan Avenue 深南大道



Shennan Avenue is the most renowned road in Shenzhen. It's just like the Mall is to London and Avenue des Champs is to Paris. It is Shenzhen's centerpoint and seamlessly connects three of its most important districts. Shenzhen Avenue has helped the city become a fast-paced metropolis that attracts hundreds of thousands investors and tourists every year. The avenue consists of three parts: Shennan road, Shennan Middle road and Shennan East road. Skyscrapers are absent along this road, which is lined by lush trees and blossoming flowers.

Shaotoujiao is a well-known area on the border of the mainland and Hong Kong in Yantian district. It has become a bustling metropolis due to the development of the special economic zone. Shaotoujiao is a busy cargo port. It has a road connecting downtown Shenzhen with regular bus services to Shenzhen's main train terminus, which is also a connection to Guangzhou. The town's attractions include Minsk World which has an aircraft carrier moored in the bay.

Longxiang Avenue 龙翔大道

the main street of Longgang district. The avenue is a 6.64-km stretch that turns into the Shuiguan Expressway at its Western end. It was constructed as a multifunctional road that serves as the centerpoint of Longgang district's development, the traffic corridor during Universiade Games and the welcome avenue for visitors. OCT East, the national ecological resort occupying about 9 square kilometers, aims to provide visitors with an opportunity to escape from the bustle of city life and return to nature. They can also visit the Shenzhen Evergreen Resort, Waterlands Resort, Guangming Farm, and Qiniang and Fenghuang mountains.

Cowboy's customer base extends beyond those wishing to grab a quick bite to those missing the flavor of authentic American food. Unlike the mass purveyors of fast food, Cowboy grills its meat instead of frying it, which means that not only are its offerings tastier but also they're significantly healthier. Basic quarter-pounder burgers cost around 20 yuan — a bargain considering the fact that you get a nice smokey chunk of meat as opposed to a greasy patty. The restaurant also provides free wireless Internet and has a decent choice of American classics, such as buffalo wings and french fries. Coffee, tea, beer and soda are also available.
